

# CUTTING HOLES FOR TAPS

Cutting holes in tiles is quite easy.

There are 3 options.

- Buy a tradesman hole cutter.
- Buy a handyman hole cutter.
- Drill and nibble the hole to the required size.

## To cut a hole for a tap or penetration with a hole cutter

### STEP 1

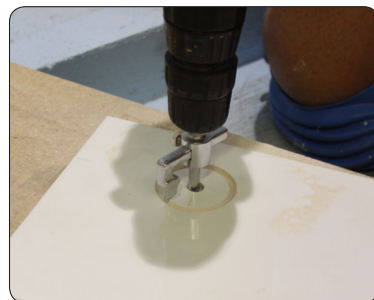
- Mark where the tile needs to be cut.
- Mark the centre of the hole.

### STEP 2

- Place some tape at the centre mark (to stop the drill from slipping on the surface)
- Place the tile over a suitable and stable surface .

### STEP 3

- Drill the hole.



## To drill a hole for a fitting

When the time comes to fit screwed accessories to a wall, there is no need to be worried.

### STEP 1

- Mark the spot where you need to drill.
- Place some tape at the centre mark.

### STEP 2

- Using tape, make a small 'well' to collect the dust.

### STEP 3

- Drill the hole. Don't use the hammer function on your drill until you have drilled through the glazed surface.
- remove the tape and the job is done.
